1. This bibliography is derived from the National Library's catalogue. Many records in the catalogue are derived from overseas databases and the standard of the records may vary.
2. Headings for authors are based on the Library of Congress Name Authority File.
3. Accents in words display immediately before the letter to which they apply; this is a catalogue constraint.
4. The books are housed together and all have call numbers beginning with COOP.
5. The serials are integrated into the Serials Collection. Some of Dr Cooper's titles were not held at all while others have increased existing holdings. Introduction to the Collection

The Dr John Cooper Theosophy Collection is a very large collection of books, serials and archival material donated by the family of Dr John Cooper, a notable Australian historian of the Theosophical Movement. Theosophy can be broadly defined as a body of religious doctrine concerned with the mysteries of divine wisdom, and more specifically is linked to the modern esoteric religious association founded in New York in 1875 by Madame H.P. Blavatsky (1831–91). The Theosophical Movement grew out of Spiritualism and drew heavily on Eastern religion and philosophy. In 1879 Madame Blavatsky visited India and established the headquarters of the Theosophical Society at Adyar, near Madras, where it is still located. Branches were subsequently established throughout most of the world, including Australia in 1894.

John Cooper obtained his Master of Arts in Religious Studies from the University of Sydney in 1986 for a thesis entitled *The Theosophical Crisis in Australia: The Story of the Breakup of the Theosophical Society in Sydney from 1913 until 1923*. Part of his collection relates to the history of the Society in Sydney, where it had a substantial impact. At the time of his death in 1998, Dr Cooper was working on a multi-volume scholarly edition of the correspondence of H.P. Blavatsky. He was posthumously awarded a PhD from the University of Sydney for a preliminary three-volume analytic study of this correspondence. During his research he built up an extensive collection of copies of all of Blavatsky's letters, and complete sets of many Theosophical publications (including *The Theosophist* from its first issue in 1879). He amassed a huge number of theosophical pamphlets, unique archival material and a wide range of books to support the courses he taught in the School of Studies in Religion at the University of Sydney on Hinduism, Buddhism and the Gnostic tradition.

Before devoting himself full-time to religious studies, Dr Cooper worked professionally in the field of arts administration. He served as state administrator and director of the Arts Council of New South Wales, as federal administrator of the Arts Council of Australia, and as a senior executive with the Australia Council. A small component of his manuscript collection relates to these activities.

The Library is privileged to be able to make these extensive resources available to scholars. To preserve the integrity of the collection, the Library has kept the books (nearly 4,000) together as a formed collection. The serials (more than 240 titles) have been integrated into the Library's Serials Collection and the archival component (thirty large boxes) is housed in the Manuscripts Stack.

Use of the Collection

This bibliography provides brief details of the books and serials in the collection. Full details can be obtained by searching the Library's online catalogue at <http://catalogue.nla.gov.au/>. As well as searching via author, title, etc., readers can retrieve records for the titles in the collection by doing a search on "Dr John Cooper Theosophy Collection" (select "as a phrase" and "Keywords" from the drop down boxes on the Advanced Search screen).

Readers visiting the National Library to use the collection will need to register in the Main Reading Room before being able to request material. Details on registration, opening hours, etc. can be found at <http://www.nla.gov.au/infoserv/rooms.html>. Once titles from the Theosophy Collection have been requested, they will need to be collected and used in the Petherick Reading Room on the Ground Floor (adjacent to the Main Reading Room).
