HOW WE CAN HELP

Grants of up to \$15 000 are available to support preservation projects undertaken by community organisations such as local historical societies, regional museums, public libraries, and Indigenous and migrant community groups, which hold cultural heritage collections of national significance. Materials may be significant because of their historic, aesthetic, research or social and spiritual values.

ACTIVITIES WE SUPPORT

A wide range of activities may qualify for grants, including:

- Preservation needs assessments of collections
- Significance assessments of collections
- Specialised preservation and collection management training for staff and volunteers
- Purchase of archival quality storage materials
- Physical treatment of documents and artefacts, including boxing, binding, and conservation
- Environmental control and storage
- Copying of material once originals have been preserved.
