


How do plants spread their seeds?

Plants use a variety of ways to spread their seeds. Some plants have pods that spring open flinging the seeds away from the parent plant, others have hooks or sticky surfaces that cling to an animal's fur and get carried away, still others pass through an animal's digestive system with the remains of the fruit the animal ate.
