



### **What is GovRAP?**

GovRAP is a free monthly reference service listing Australia's recent government publishing output.

The records are derived from the Australian National Bibliographic Database (ANBD) which is maintained by the National Library of Australia. Records from GovRAP are a subset of the ANBD and are created by Australian libraries.

The files are available in alphabetical and Dewey format. The alphabetical file is a complete list of new records for items published by Australian Government Departments that have been added to the ANBD in the nominated month and the Dewey classified file is a subset of those records that contain Dewey numbers. The files are available in text format or directly on the web.

### **How current is GovRAP?**

Each publication listed has been published during the current or previous two years by an Australian Government Department or Agency.

### **Why use GovRAP?**

There are great advantages in using this list for collection management of government publications. It's also very useful for all engaged in research and the provision of information as you can link straight to the Libraries Australia record with holdings information and options for accessing items.

### **How much does GovRAP cost?**

You can download the records free of charge.
