Read the panels on display to discover the types of events recorded in Australia's newspapers. Find the missing word, and complete your crossword!

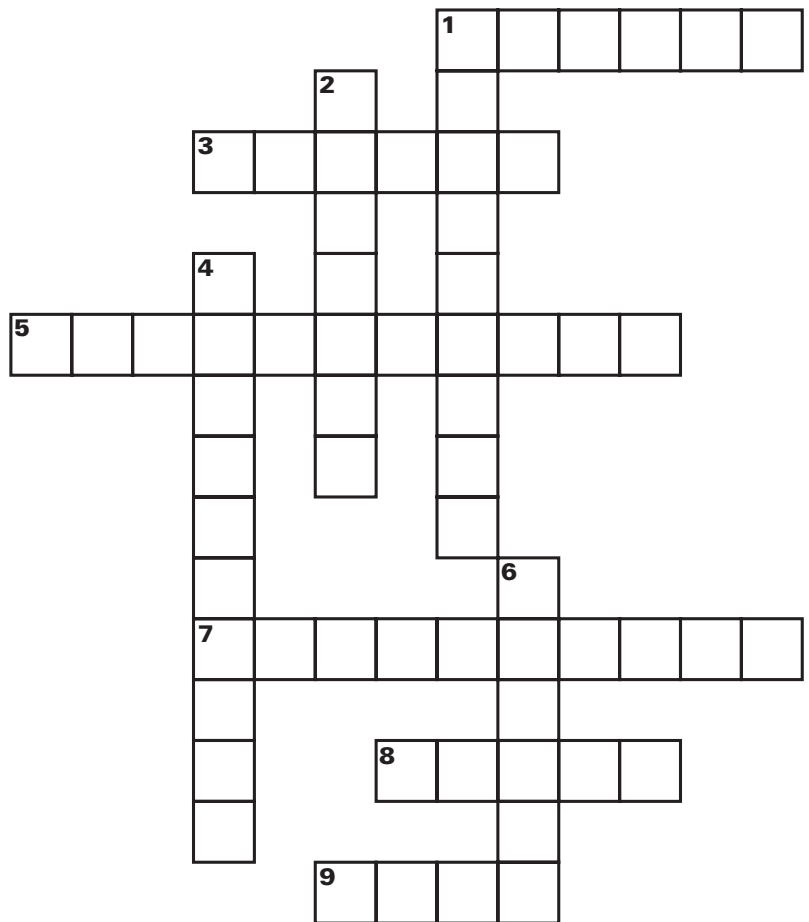
