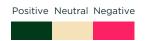

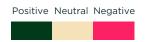

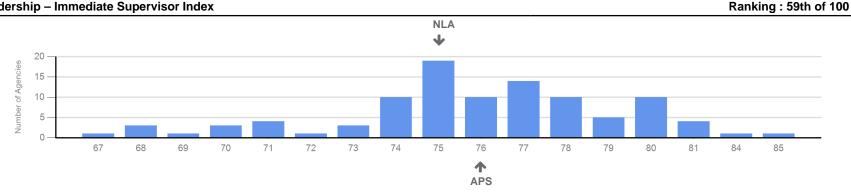

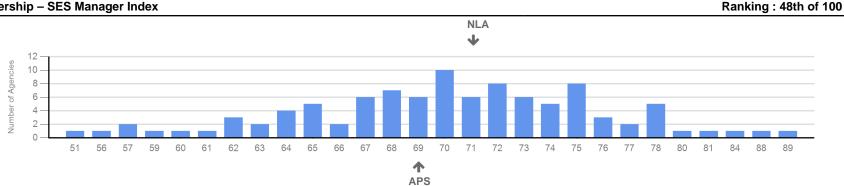




Leadership - Immediate Supervisor Index

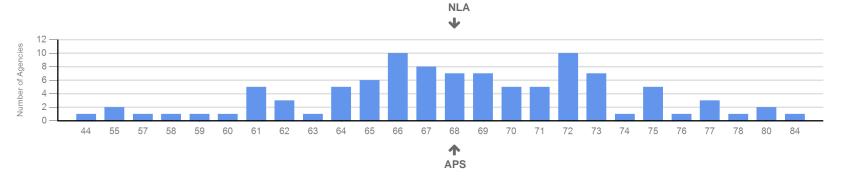

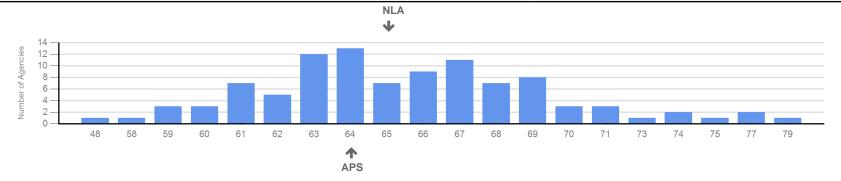

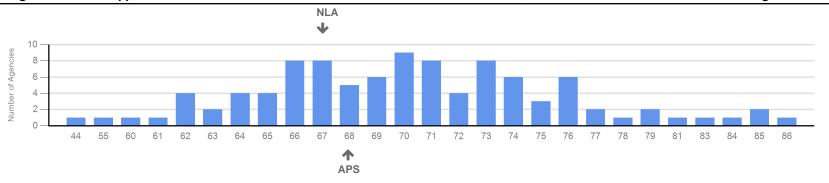
