Most of the lists were compiled by searchers in the Public Record Office in London who were selecting records for filming by the Australian Joint Copying Project. The compilers included Janet Hine and Phyllis Mander-Jones, who were the Public Library of New South Wales' liaison officers in London between 1954 and 1960, and temporary staff engaged by the National Library of Australia's liaison officer in London. In addition, there are lists compiled by staff of the Mitchell Library in Sydney of AJCP film received from London. These lists are usually marked up with the AJCP reel numbers.

Some of the lists simply give the titles of pieces within a class and they have been superseded by the *Australian Joint Copying Project Handbooks* (11 vols.). Of more lasting value to researchers are the lists of classes that did not relate specifically to the Australian and New Zealand colonies and which were therefore filmed selectively. These lists indicated to the photographer which particular documents within a piece were to be filmed and to some extent they resemble a calendar of documents. Whereas the *Handbooks* simply contain statements such as 'Selected extracts only have been copied from all pieces', some of the lists on this reel identify the precise extracts that were filmed.
