I have a small project that needs to be completed by the end of June that I wondered if some of you involved in the Android catalog app development might be willing/able to take on.

The project is to convert structured data corresponding to handcrafted indexing of an historic newspaper into pdf epub (one for each year of publication of the newspaper that has been indexed). Two pieces of work are required.

The first is a one off conversion of ten years of data is held in an Oracle database and currently is delivered as the web service Argus Index - (<http://www.nla.gov.au/argus>).

The second is to develop an application that the indexers can use to produce new pdfs as they complete indexing another year of the newspaper. This index data is in the form of a particular text format produced by the software used by the indexers. Currently there are possibly ten years of indexing data ready to publish (in addition to that currently in The Argus Index). We have previously developed scripts that check and load these into our oracle database.

We can provide data exported from Oracle, definition of the PDF layout, current import conversion scripts and examples of import ready data.

If you are interested can we discuss further please.
